The Centre management will have overnight security in operation but no responsibility is accepted by the Ayr Classic Motorcycle Club or any of its representatives, or the operators of The Rowallan Activity Centre for loss or damage to any goods or exhibits while stored or located within the arena or its environs prior to, during, or after the show.*

## Details for Non – Trade & Club Stands:

The Ayr Classic Motorcycle Club intends that this event remains as one organised by enthusiasts for enthusiasts and we would be delighted to have club or associated organisations take a stand at this year's show. The show presents an ideal opportunity for both one – make and local area motorcycle clubs to canvass new members, as well as giving the opportunity for inter – club discussion.

Non – Trade and Club stand space will be free for the first unit, and for any subsequent units as available. Stands could take the form of a mini club display with classic machines, or purely a meeting point for like minded enthusiasts. Two exhibitors' passes will be issued for stand attendants.

Stand space is available in blocks of a frontage 3.0m wide by 3.0m deep. Corner stands may be a bit wider and have greater stand area but sites are assigned to give a good spread of interest throughout the show area and so are based on the minimum size available. Several blocks can be combined to give a large frontage. Allocation of stand space will be at the discretion of the show committee.

A number of display tables (£2.00 each) are available on the day but are on a “First come - First served” basis, so if you do require any tables please get your booking in early to avoid disappointment. Mains power will be available (£1.00) but is restricted and stands requiring power will be situated to suit the fixed power distribution points - again get your application in early if you need power.

The Show will be open to the public from 10 a.m. until 4 p.m. on both days of the show. Access for stand staff is available from 8 pm until 10 pm on Friday 4th and Saturday 5th, and from 7 am on Saturday and Sunday. **NOTE THAT ALL EXHIBITS MUST BE IN PLACE BY 9.30 A.M.** All exhibits etc must be cleared from the arena by Sunday 6.30 pm after close of show. There will be overnight security in operation but no responsibility is accepted by the Ayr Classic Motorcycle Club or any of its representatives, or the operators of the Rowallan Activity Centre for loss or damage to any goods or exhibits while stored or located within the arena or its environs prior to, during, or after the show. Late entries may be accepted if space permits but will not appear in the Event brochure.

Print out the application form, fill it in and sign the disclaimer and post off to the address on the form. Just remember entries need to be submitted by the 22nd May 2010 to be included in the catalogue.

**STANDS CANNOT BE DISMANTLED BEFORE 4. P.M. on the day of the show and NO VEHICLES WILL BE ALLOWED INTO THE ARENA UNTIL 4.30 P.M. AT THE EARLIEST.**

This allows for exhibitors' machines to be moved out of the arena giving space for general access.
